GUIDELINES TO PARTICIPATE IN COMPETITION

SHORT PRESENTATION COMPETITION

- Skilled entrepreneurs/industry and academia leaders, researchers, and students can submit their presentations in PowerPoint format.
- The presentation should focus on indigenous/advanced skills being utilized in Pakistan.
- One paragraph of the speech summary, along with the presenter photograph, will be published in the booklet.
- Registration is free and mandatory

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY COMPETITION

- Original photograph in a digital format (JPEG, TIFF, GIF, unedited digital pictures).
- Should depict indigenous skills of Pakistan, preferably craftsmanship and handicraft.

- A short explanation of the work should accompany each photograph in a couple of paragraphs.
- Registration is free and mandatory.

VIDEO DOCUMENTARY COMPETITION

- A short documentary/interview should focus on the skilled workforce.
- The documentary may comprise discussions with skilled workers & depicting his/her indigenous skills.
- The theme of the documentary/interview is to promote sustenance of the skills during and post-pandemic.
- The challenges suffered by the skilled worker during the pandemic.
- Precautionary measures by skilled workers in the current scenario.
- A short introduction to the documentary should be submitted at the time of registration/submission.

ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

- Preferable length 700- 1000 words.
- Describe and depict the innovative ways of imparting skills-based education during and post COVID-19 era.
- Registration is free and mandatory.
